
BOOKS OF THE BIBLE



'Bible' means 'BOOKS'! So it's like a library, with many different types of books (history, poetry, letters and prophecy). It was written by around 40 authors over 1600 years, on 3 continents! Yet it all links together to tell us one big story about God and humanity.

So get ready for a 28 day adventure to discover some of the stories found in the first part of the Bible, The Old Testament. You can find the reading for each day in a Bible, on biblegateway.com (the puzzles use the Good News Translation), or in the Children's Bible (CB) from Bibles For Children.

HOW TO FIND A READING

- First, look in the contents page and find the BOOK (e.g. Genesis).
- Then look at the first number that is the CHAPTER (e.g. Genesis 1).
- •Then look at the second number that is the VERSE within the chapter (e.g. Genesis 1v31).

The first chapter of the Bible makes it clear that God is the grand architect of the world, and it sets the scene for everything that follows...




